# Key Areas of Learning

As Geographers, we will be focussing on some outdoor learning. We will complete some orienteering on school site and ensure we are able to follow a map and use a compass. We will be writing mathematical clues for other children to deduce the answer and follow our trail around the JHN site.

As Scientists we will be conducting some extraordinary experiments. We will take what we have learnt so far during Year 6 and apply this to some hands-on learning. We will write up our experiments so we are able to reflect on what went well and what we will need to put in place for next time. We will also spend some time going over electricity, creating circuits and thinking scientifically.

Within Art, we will be looking at our school logo 'Let Your Light Shine.' We will be designing images around this theme and working in groups to ensure they link to our school motto. We will then be painting these to be displayed around the school site in a collage effect to ensure one picture is created over multiple images.

## English

We will have a SATS focus on our SPaG to begin the term and then we will end the term by creating a SATS guide for the next group of children to come into Year 6!

We will focus on:

- Determiners
- Prepositions
- Clauses
- Conjunctions
- Punctuation marks
- Word classes
- Standard English/ formality
- Sentence structure

## Mathematics

During maths lessons in Term 5 we will be revising some of the topics we have missed due to the pandemic as well as recapping some of the more challenging mathematical concepts. We will be looking, in more detail, at:

- Addition and subtraction
- Multiplication and division
- Fractions, Decimals and Percentages
- Reasoning and problem solving
- Word problems
- Algebra
- Volume

We will be looking at these key areas in preparation for our SATS.

### Religious Education

Within RE, we will be learning about Islam. We will be studying the question, 'Does belief in Akhirah (life after death) help Muslims lead good lives?'

### PSHE

In PSHE we will be focussing on the Jigsaw piece Relationships. There will be a focus on mental health and how we can look after our mental as well as our physical health.

We will be learning how to play rounders. We will be working as a team to learn how to bat and field. This will include batting and throwing skills.
