Key Areas of Learning

World War II
1939 - 1945



As **Historians** we will be continuing to study World War Two. We will start to complete our study on an aspect of British history from a period beyond 1066 that is significant to Littlemore and the rest of Oxfordshire. We will be looking at a variety of sources and trying to use them confidently whilst researching. We will be looking into why and how the War started and what it meant for the people of Britain.

As **Scientists** we will be studying the topic Light. We will learn that light appears to travel in straight lines and then begin to use this idea to explain that objects are seen because they give out (or reflect) light into the eye. We will also use this idea to explain why shadows have the same shape as the objects that cast them.

Within **Art**, we will be looking at the Blitz in more detail. We will be using chalk and oil pastels to create different effects through shading. We will also be using different colours to highlight the difference between light and dark.

English

In English, we will be reading the books 'Rose Blanche' by Ian McEwan and 'The Lion, The Witch and the Wardrobe' by C S Lewis. We will be using these stories to write a range of texts, which will be both fiction and non-fiction.

We will also be focussing on our reading skills, looking at the different content domains to ensure we are answering comprehension questions accurately. We will also be reading regularly to develop our vocabulary.

Mathematics

During maths lessons in Term 4 we will be focussing on the following areas:

- Statistics
- Shape
- Area, Perimeter and Volume
- Revision

We will explore reasoning and problem solving within each aspect of maths. We will also be working on our arithmetic skills daily within all of our lessons starting with a Quick 10.

Religious Education

Within RE, we will be looking at the question 'Is anything every eternal?' We will be delving into the Christian faith to look at what Christians believe is eternal and why.

PSHE

In PSHE we will be focussing on the Jigsaw piece Healthy Me. We will be looking at how to take responsibility for our own health and well being and working on strategies to ensure we are healthy

Physical Education

We will be completing a variety of activities while at home, varying the types of exercise to help create a broad set of skills.

Computing

In year 6, we will be focusing on 'Presentation' using Google Slides. We will learn to create a presentation on 'World War'.

Music

As musicians we will be looking at some old War Time music. We will learn some of the famous songs and practice some dancing from the war era.

French

In French we will be learning the numbers 1-12 as well as how to ask questions to our friends and build up our conversational skills.
